### Race, Equity, & Inclusion Requirement 3-6 CREDIT HOURS

Fall 2023 Forward -- Degree-seeking UG students admitted or readmitted Fall 2023 forward must Complete one course that satisfies the U.S. component and one course that satisfies the global component from the list of approved Race, Equity, and Inclusion (REI) Requirement (6 credit hours). Approved REI courses may also fulfill other degree requirements (e.g. general education, major, minor, First Year Experience, or Founding Documents). The two courses do not have to be taken from the same department or in sequence. Transfer students with 45 or more earned transfer credit hours at the time of admission or readmission, are required to complete only one REI-designated course, either U.S. or Global.
