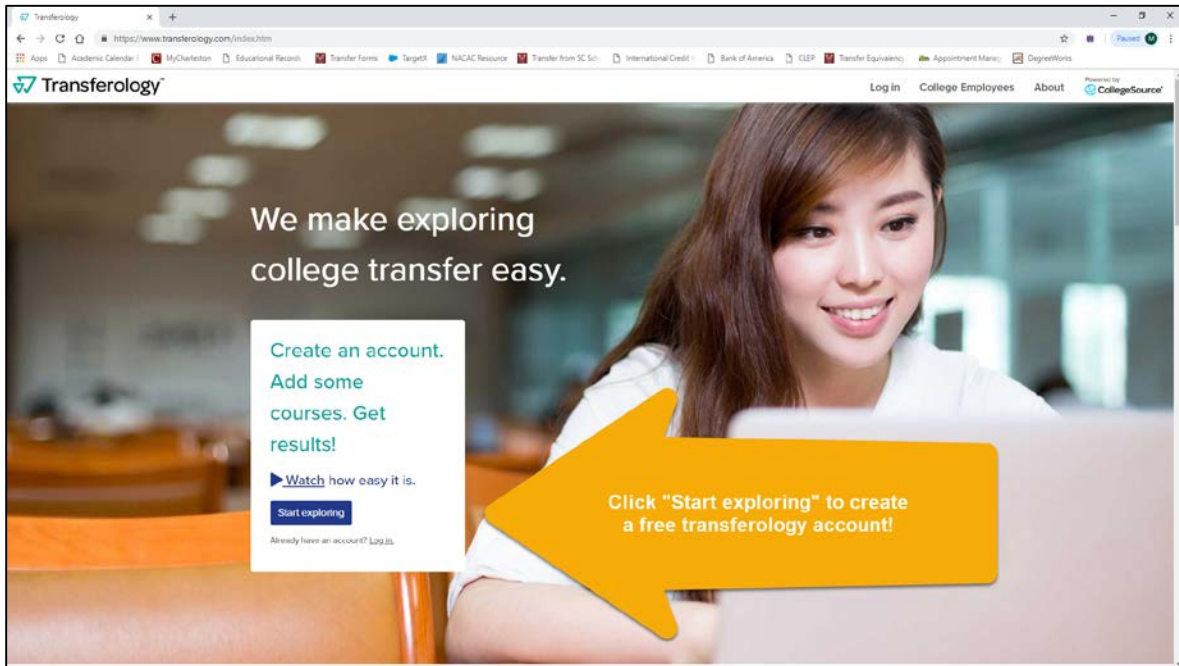


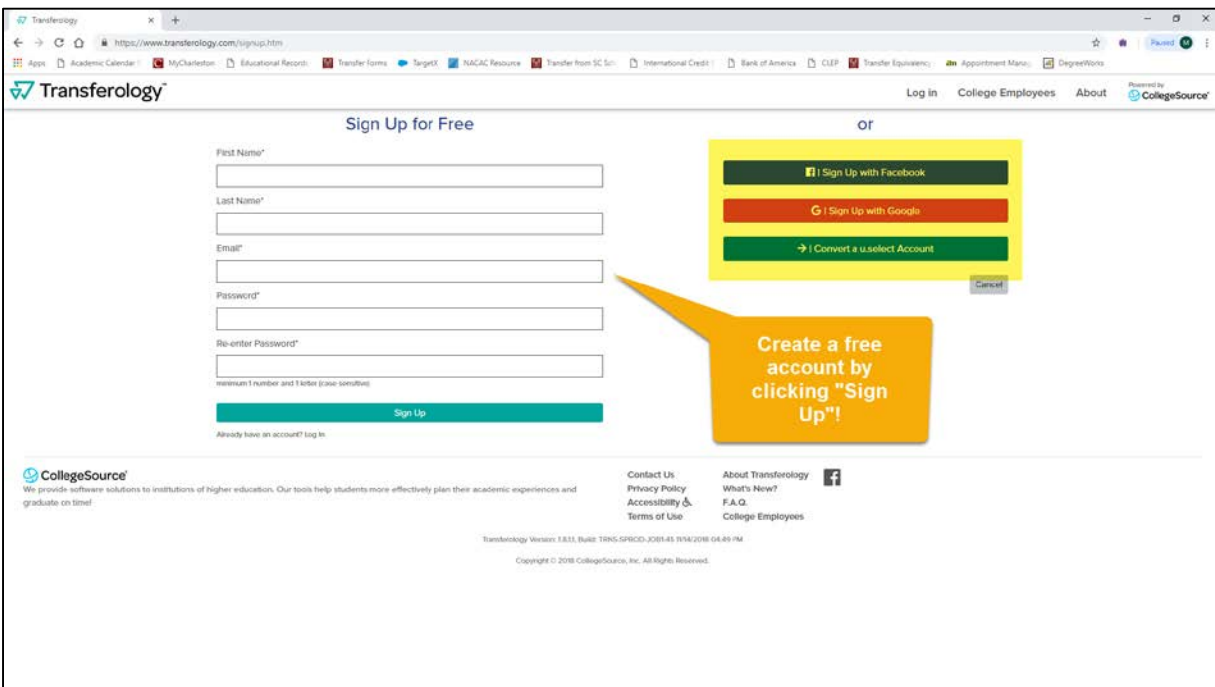


HOW WILL MY COURSES TRANSFER?

Go to <https://www.transferology.com/school/cofc> to create a free student account. Click on “Start Exploring” or “Log in” to enter your credentials. On this home page you will also find a few tutorials for using the many tools Transferology has to offer.




Enter your credentials to create a free account. Note that you can also sign up using Facebook, Google, and u.select.

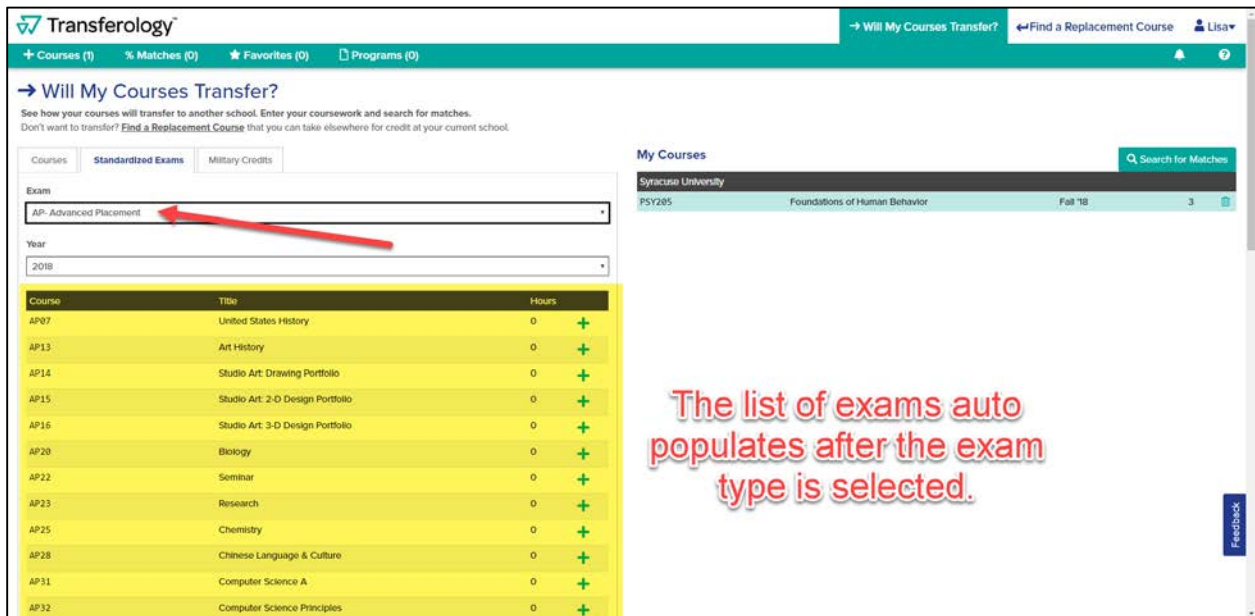

Adding Standardized Exams

Click on the “Standardized Exams” tab under Will My Courses Transfer?



Select the type of standardized exam from the dropdown list. (i.e. Advanced Placement, CLEP, International Baccalaureate, etc.)



Next, you need to select the year the exam was taken.

Add the exam to your list of “My Courses” by clicking on the plus (+) symbol to the right of the exam you’ve taken.

Note: All exams will show as the term being “Winter.” This has no effect on the equivalency. The process is the same for adding Advanced Placement (AP), College Level Examination Program (CLEP), and International Baccalaureate (IB) exams.

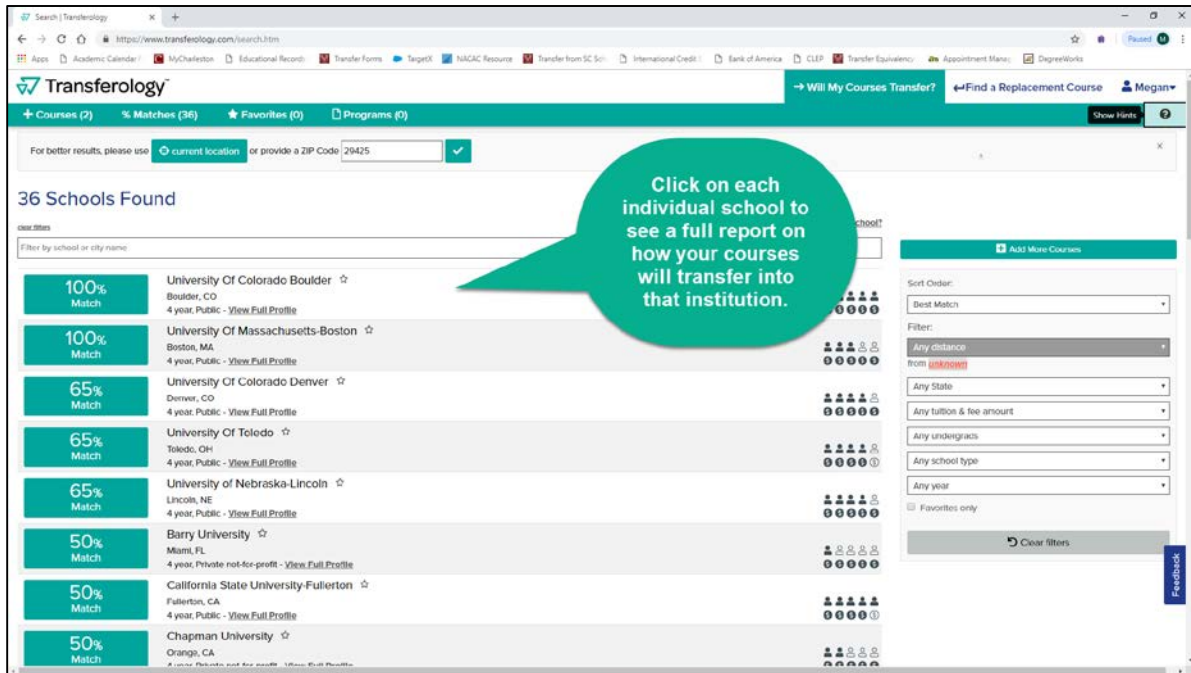
Click “Search for Matches” to see results on institutions with transfer equivalencies.

Note on the top left hand corner of the screen you can bounce between the course selection and results screen.

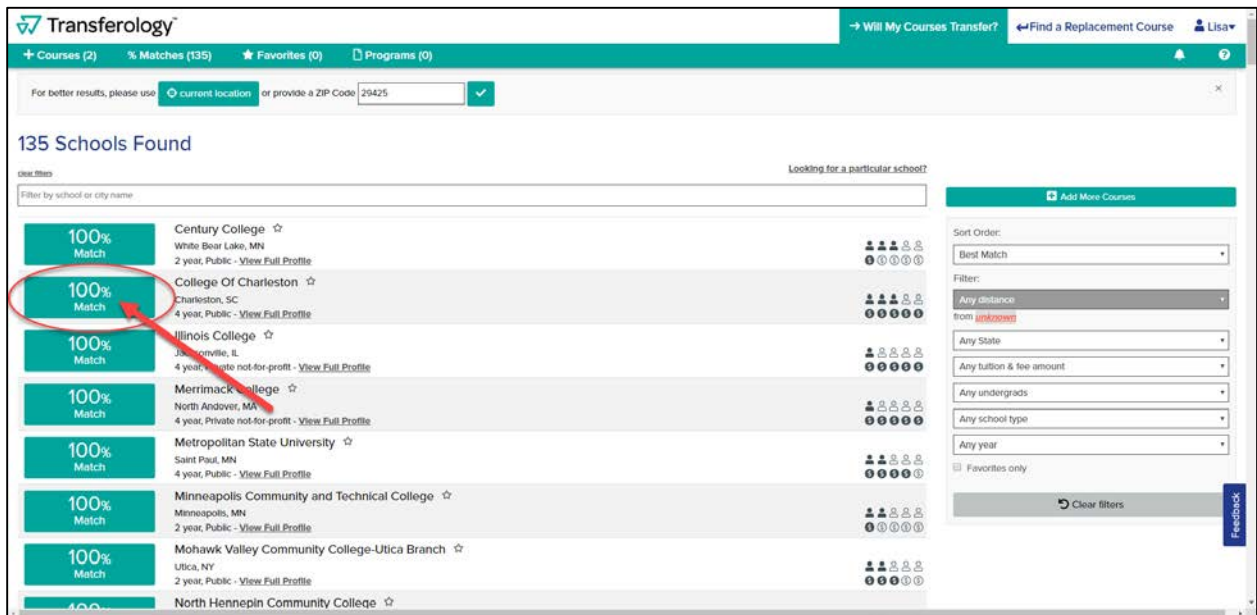

Filter your results by using the drop-down menus on the right hand side of the screen. You may filter information by state, tuition and fees, available degree programs, school types (liberal arts, business schools etc...), or distance. Notice the bar on the top of the screen that allows you to search using your current location or zip code. For searching for institutions close to home or close to your current school, use this tool to filter.



For more information about your course equivalencies, click on the “% Match” button to the left of each institution’s name.




The highlighted areas on the right hand side of the screen allow you to see more detailed information about the school you chose. Note that there are links to the institution’s website under “Information Links”.

Transfer courses will fall into one of three categories in Transferology:

1. Match – institution has an equivalency on file
2. Miss – institution does not accept this course for transfer
3. Maybe – institution does not have an equivalency on file for this course and will need more information to determine if it is a transferrable course

To view what courses fall under the match, miss, or maybe category, click the corresponding tab on the upper left side of the screen.





For course matches, the course equivalencies are listed on the left side of the screen. Courses are grouped by sending/previous institution and are organized using the format below:

[Course number and title at previous institution] → [CofC course equivalent]

Click “Expand all notes” to see additional information regarding how these courses will transfer to CofC. This is important to do for placement exams, because many exam equivalencies are based on exam score.
